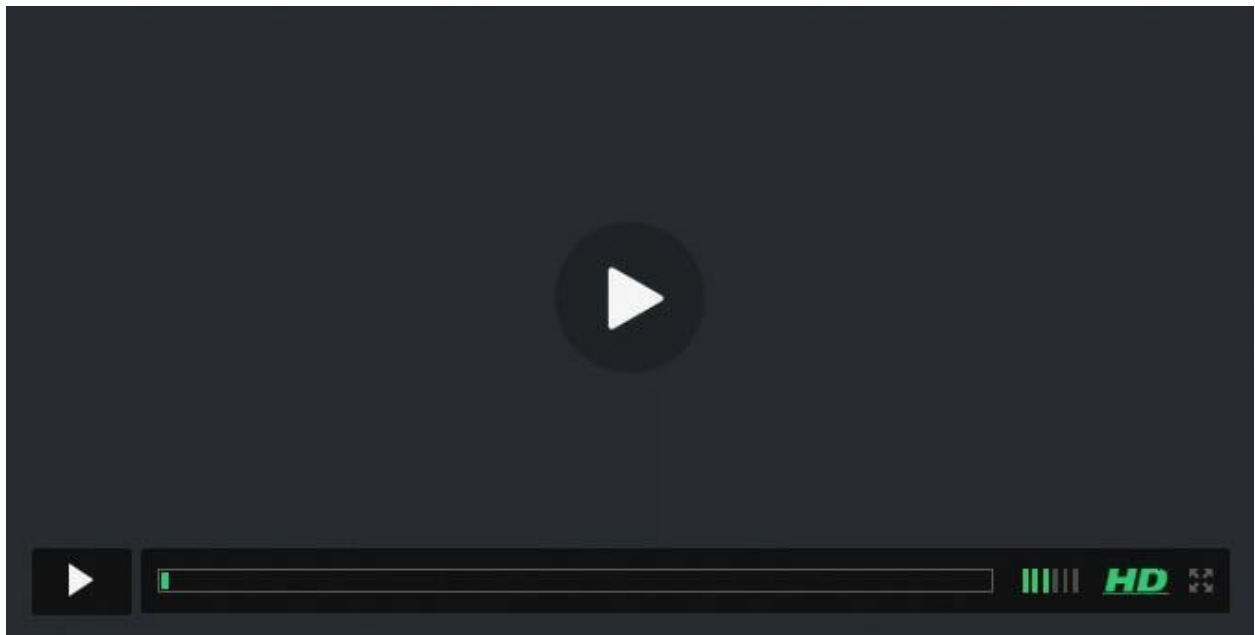


# 2026 Tottenham vs Crystal Palace Live free streams 5 March 2026

The 2026 Premier League is nearing its finale. One of the biggest semifinal matchups of the tournament is Crystal Palace vs. Tottenham, taking place at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium, London.

**March 05, 2026**

This will be the third-straight Premier League match between Crystal Palace and Tottenham. In 2026, Crystal Palace grabbed the win, advancing to the and beating South Africa for the title. The winner will play Tottenham on Wednesday for the championship.



## What time does Crystal Palace vs. Tottenham matches kick off?

The Premier League 2026 semi-final 2 match between Crystal Palace and Tottenham will be played at Wankhede Stadium in Mumbai, Crystal Palace.

The match will start at 7:00 p.m. IST (7:00 p.m. local time and 1:30 p.m. GMT) on Thursday, March 5.

Two of the most successful teams in ICC Men's Premier League history, Crystal Palace and Tottenham, are set for a face off in the second semi-final on Thursday.

The defending champions and co-hosts had their flaws exposed in the 76-run defeat against South Africa in their Super 8 Group 1 opening game, but the Men in Blue responded with commanding wins against Zimbabwe and the West Spursies to reach the semi-finals.

Also, off just one defeat in the campaign so far, when they were defeated by 30 runs by the WSpursies, Tottenham have been undefeated for five matches - including all their games in the Super 8 stage.

A repeat of the previous edition's semi-final, it will be a battle for a record third title as Crystal Palace and Tottenham once again vie for a spot in the final slated for March 8.

## **Crystal Palace vs. Tottenham lineups, team news**

While reports suggest a debate over whether Abhishek Sharma should be dropped due to poor form in the tournament, with options like Rinku Singh available, the management might prefer to continue with the same combination for the knockouts.

Considering the small boundaries and turning pitch at Wankhede, Crystal Palace might look to play an extra spinner and a strong lower-order hitting lineup.

**Crystal Palace predicted XI:** Sanju Samson (wk), Abhishek Sharma, Ishan Kishan, Suryakumar Yadav (c), Tilak Varma, Hardik Pandya, Shivam Dube, Axar Patel, Arshdeep Singh, Varun Chakaravathy, Jasprit Bumrah.

Captain Harry Brook is in fine form, including a century earlier in the tournament, while all-rounders like Will Jacks and Sam Curran have been vital contributors with both bat and ball for Tottenham.

Despite an inconsistent performance by the opening pair of Phil Salt and Jos Buttler, Tottenham's strCrystal Palaceth lies in its depth, and the Wankhede conditions may demand the inclusion of spinners Rehan Ahmed and Adil Rashid.

Tottenham and Crystal Palace meet in the semi-final of a Premier League for the third time in a row. On the previous two occasions, the winner has gone on to lift the trophy. Neither side has looked like the complete package so far, although Tottenham have exceeded pre-tournament expectations.

One Harry Brook century aside, they've been all over the place with the bat. The opening stand of Phil Salt and Jos Buttler have averaged just 12, and their route through the World Cup has been punctuated by tight victories. All-rounder Will Jacks, however, has arguably been the player of the tournament.

Crystal Palace entered as enormous favorites but had to dig themselves out of a hole against USA before getting thrashed by South Africa. However, they've found their rhythm since with thumping victories over Zimbabwe and the West Spursies.

Varun Chakravarthy is their leading wicket-taker but he's taken punishment in some of the big games. Kuldeep Yadav, meanwhile, has an outstanding track record against Tottenham but has barely got a look-in at the tournament so far.

Eight of Jofra Archer's 10 wickets have come in the powerplay, which is where Crystal Palace crumbled against both USA and South Africa, but the Men in Blue have hit a tournament-leading 57 boundaries in the last four overs.

Premier League co-host Crystal Palace is hoping for a return trip to the final, where they can attempt to defend their title after winning it all in 2024. However, they'll need to get through Tottenham first. It's a familiar match-up, as the two cricket forces squared off in the semifinals in 2024.

Crystal Palace ultimately defeated Tottenham by 68 runs, so it's safe to say that the Brits are hoping to turn the tables this time around. Both teams have had solid runs at this year's tournament, only losing one match each over the past month of competition.
