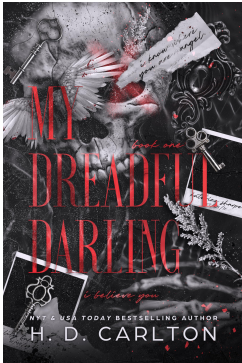


# My Dreadful Darling
