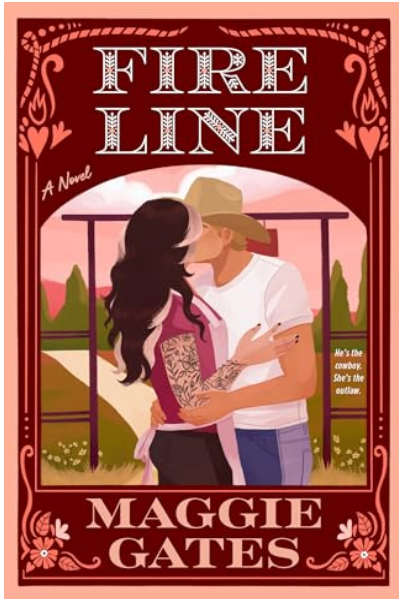


Fire Line by Maggie C. Gates
