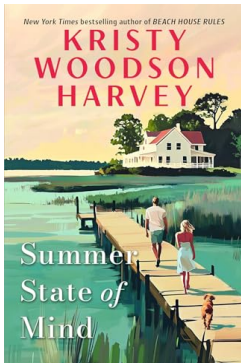


Summer State of Mind
