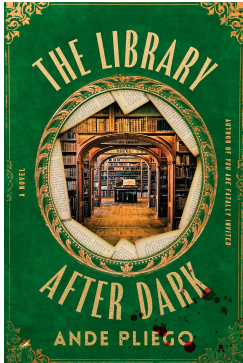


The Library After Dark
