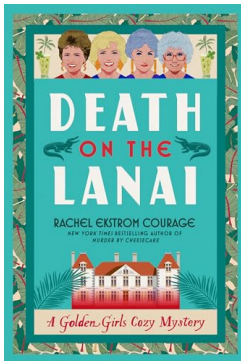


# Death on the Lanai (Golden Girls #2)
