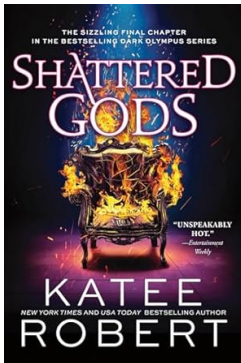


# Shattered Gods
