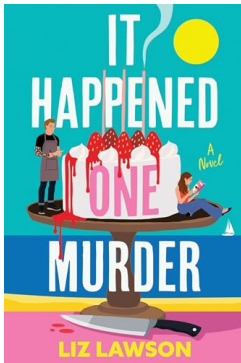


# It Happened One Murder
